School bus registration


School bus registration is open now for the 2024-25 school year! Students must be registered every year for the school bus.

As we have done in past years, the school will be purchasing school supplies for the next school year. The price will be \$40 (Kindergarten) and \$70 (Grades 1 – 3). The student fee will be used to cover school supplies and special events.
