On Wednesday, October 27, 2021, the Grey Mountain Primary School Council voted on and passed a motion to trigger a January 2022 referendum for Grey Mountain Primary to consider joining the Yukon First Nation School Board. (YFNSB).

The decision was not unanimous and was made after significant deliberation.

The majority of council members felt it was best for the Grey Mountain Primary school community to have a say on this important decision.

We encourage all parents and guardians to learn more about the YFNSB so they can make an informed decision when voting in the upcoming referendum.
