All families are invited to our Welcome Back To School festivities!




12:00noon – BBQ lunch 12:30pm – Open house. Parents are invited to visit their child's classroom.

© <u>Student Safety</u>

The parking lot located on the school grounds is for **staff only** between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm. A reminder that students being dropped off by vehicle should be **let out on Alsek Road** and should be instructed on how to enter the school grounds safely **using crosswalks and sidewalks**. City bylaw states that cars have to be parked 5 meters from the crosswalk. Students with bicycles are asked to lock them up at the bicycle stands.

Emergency Evacuation Sites

This is a reminder to parents that if an emergency arises that results in an evacuation of the school where it is not safe to re-enter, our "**safe location**" is **Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses** (across the street) 191 Alsek Rd. (667-4304).

Our "alternate location" will be: **St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Secondary School**, 16 Duke Street (formerly Vanier).
